Rustenburg Rapid Transport (RRT) on course to delivering smart, safe, reliable and consistent public transport to the people of the community.

Rustenburg – The Rustenburg Local Municipality continues to make great progress in the implementation of the Integrated Rapid Transport System to provide a safe, reliable, universally accessible public transport system.

The on-going construction works for the development of the infrastructure has led to the creation of numerous job opportunities and skills development for locals offered by the contractors.

Platinum Weekly has learned that in the Thabane area, for instance, 1200 locals have been engaged by the main contractors to carry out various skilled and unskilled jobs in plumbing, paving, subcontracting and general labour amongst others.

The Bus Rapid Transport system was named Yarona - 'It is Ours' in Setswana, and was launched in 2014. Upon completion, the project would include trunk corridors, direct routes and feeder services that connect with existing systems of minibus taxis, buses

and the highway ensuring seamless mobility around the city and surrounding areas.

The implementation of the project continues to spur economic growth in Rustenburg, through upgrades in public physical infrastructure within a well-planned spatial context and has laid the ground for sustainable job creation, promotion of local businesses and stimulation of investment growth within Rustenburg.

Yarona is promoting alternative modes of transportation including non-motorised transportation (NMT) facilities, universally accessible public transport, and solutions to traffic congestion, air pollution while promoting road safety.

"We are incorporating non-motorised travel to make street environments safer and more pleasant for users. This is another important step towards a future in which we will not necessarily need a car to get around our city," RRT director Marks Rapoo told the Platinum Weekly newspaper on Friday, 19

May 2017.

Yarona has embraced universal access as a major component of the project and accommodates people living with disabilities, the elderly and those with special needs.

Already, there is substantial progress in the construction works on the 5,3 kilometre stretch from Thabane to the CBD with dedicated lanes and NMTs.

The roads construction within the CBD is progressing well in Nelson Mandela Drive, Oliver Tambo Drive and Thabo Mbeki Drive. There are various alternative routes and re-routing of traffic that have been implemented. Circulation of vehicles in the CBD is via Beneden Street. Traffic leading into town is re-routed to Foord Street and into Benoni Street, into Scheiding Street, Middel Street, into Beneden Street and leading to the taxi rank. Construction of six stations along the Yarona route is progressing well and so is implementation of the North East corridor (R510-Thabazimbi Road).
