Rustenburg – Child Welfare SA Rustenburg in cooperation with the *Die Rots* Church, built a Children's Home that can accommodate approximately 100 children. The building is nearing completion.

There are currently seven children living in the Children's Home, yet with a capacity of 100, many more children can be accommodated. However, there is a desperate need for furniture for the units that will be housing the children. Before the children can move in, Child Welfare is asking for donations.

Besides being tax deductible, if a company donates all the furniture for a specific unit,

they may choose the name for that unit. Smaller donations are also welcome. Please see the list attached at the end of the article. The building also has to be tiled. The ground floor, as well as the first floor, each with a surface of 650m² will have to be tiled. Lastly, they need security gates and an alarm system to keep the kids safe.

The social workers who will be responsible for these children, are employed by Child Welfare SA, and will work with the Children's Home.

Their offices are next to the children's home, on the premises of *Die Rots* Church. These

social workers get help from people like Roxy van den Berg, president of KVK Rustenburg, a volunteer club which helps children in the children's home with necessities such as stationary and clothing. You can follow them on Facebook on their page *Kindersorg Vrywilliger Klub*.


