

MEC launches Tourism Month in Rustenburg

Rustenburg/ Phokeng – September, also known as Tourism Month, was kicked off with a bang on Friday 1 September at the Royal Marang Hotel in Phokeng. Launching this thrilling month of Tourism and Heritage in our country, MEC Desbo Mohono of the North-West Department of Tourism, addressed the audience at the Official Provincial Tourism Month Launch and Media Tour.

The purpose of tourism month is to encourage South Africans to explore their own country. It provides the tourism industry with a sustained, heightened month-long focus on the importance of domestic tourism on the economy.

"Today we launch Tourism Month amid challenges that the Department has been through. It is for this reason that the sector has been prioritised in the New Growth path and the Industrial Policy Action Plan 2017/18-2019/20 by our government. Within the context of the triple challenges of poverty, unemployment and inequality, it is perhaps the National Tourism Sector's Strategy that succinctly captures the essence of the tourism sector as a catalyst for local growth and development," said Desbo Mohono, North-West MEC for Tourism.

"Recent statistics from 2016 and 2017 clearly depict a picture of steady growth

within the North West Province. According to African Source Markets Performance (ASMP) 2016 and Statistics South Africa Report (Stats SA 2015/16/17) the total number of African tourist arrivals to the North West Province in late 2016 stands at 788 277 out of 893 318 international arrivals," MEC Mohono said.

The most international African arrivals come from Botswana, with a staggering 466 264 arrivals, with formal bed nights standing at 143 000 mostly sleeping for about three nights and contributing to a whopping R800 million. The second country that's boosting our economy happens to be none other than Lesotho standing at 101

982 arrivals, with a whopping R177 million contributed, followed by Mozambique, Zimbabwe and Lastly Malawi.

"We are working in close partnership with the private sector to enable new entrants to come in and contribute to the tourism industry's diversity. These efforts support our 'We Do Tourism' and the '5 in 5' strategy to attract five million additional domestic and international travellers to South Africa in the next five years, including business travellers," MEC Mohono added.

This Year's mantra is 'Sustainable Tourism – A tool for development as declared by the United Nations'.
