Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg – The discovery of illegal explosives in two separate intelligence-driven police operations in Rustenburg has raised urgent concerns about how such highly dangerous materials are circulating so freely within our communities.

In the first operation, members of the SAPS Crime Combating Unit arrested three Mozambican nationals, aged 19, 30 and 36, at the Snake Park informal settlement near Rustenburg on Sunday, 5 January 2026. The arrests followed the recovery of a vehicle that had been hijacked in Bokamoso in December. Investigations led police to a second address, where a third suspect was found in possession of explosives.

Just one day later, on Tuesday, 6 January, a separate covert operation by the SAPS Phokeng K9 Unit resulted in the arrest of a 35-year-old

man allegedly involved in the illegal sale of explosives. Acting on intelligence, undercover officers were led to Freedom Park, where the suspect allegedly demanded payment and supplied explosive materials. A follow-up search at his residence uncovered additional hidden explosives.

Police confirmed that these seized items, valued at approximately R30,000, included explosive gels, detonators, starters and stoppers – materials capable of causing devastating harm if misused.

All suspects are expected to appear before the Rustenburg Magistrate's Court on charges relating to the possession and unlawful distribution of explosives, as well as possession of a hijacked motor vehicle. Investigations are ongoing, and further charges have not been ruled out.

Beyond the arrests, these cases raise troubling questions: where are these explosives coming from, and how are they finding their way into informal settlements and neighbourhoods? Authorities have reiterated that public cooperation is vital.

Anyone with information about illegal explosives, suspicious activity, or individuals discussing the sale or movement of such materials is urged to contact the police immediately. Reporting information could prevent tragedy – and save lives.

Rustenburg loses a legend, farewell Dr Pieter Wicht

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg has lost one of its greatest pillars. On 9 January 2026, Dr Pieter Wicht passed away, leaving behind a community profoundly shaped by his life's work. For decades, his name was synonymous with care, reassurance and unwavering dedication. To many, he was more than a doctor — he was *their* doctor.

With 42 years in medicine, including 37 years of devoted service to Rustenburg, Dr Wicht touched countless lives. He had a rare and remarkable gift: the ability to make every patient feel seen, safe and genuinely cared for. He did not simply treat symptoms; he treated people — always with kindness, patience and humanity. Local Choice Pharmacy described him as a treasured member of the TLC Cornerstone family and a true legend in the community. Their words echo what so many feel: Dr Wicht was an absolute cornerstone of Rustenburg, someone whose compassion extended far beyond the

consultation room. Generations of families grew up under his care. He celebrated recoveries, offered comfort in difficult moments, and stood steadfast during times of uncertainty. His calm presence and gentle manner became a source of strength for patients and colleagues alike.

Beyond his calling as a healer, Dr Wicht was a devoted family man who loved deeply and wholeheartedly. He is survived by his beloved wife Vea, his daughter Allyson, his son-in-law Johannes, and his cherished grandson Hans. The community holds them close in thought and prayer during this time of immense loss.

If a job asks for your wallet, WALK AWAY!

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg – Residents of Rustenburg are being urged to stay alert after a surge of fake job offers began circulating on social media and community WhatsApp groups.

According to a notice issued by the Rustenburg Local Municipality's communications unit on 8 January 2026, fraudsters are falsely claiming to offer employment opportunities within Rustenburg Local Municipality. These messages often look convincing, but their goal is simple: to trick job seekers into handing over money or personal information.

The municipality has made it clear that no legitimate municipal job offer will ever require payment, banking details, or personal documents such as ID copies as a condition for employment. Any message asking for these details in exchange for a job should immediately raise red flags.

REMEMBER!

- Verify job opportunities only through the official Rustenburg Local Municipality website or by contacting the municipality directly.
- Ignore and delete messages or calls that ask for money, banking details, or personal information related to job offers.
- Report suspicious messages to the South African Police Service (SAPS) and to the municipality.

As unemployment continues to place pressure on many households, scammers often prey on hope and urgency. Do not fall victim to employment scams.

Groceries stolen, seven arrested as police recover hijacked vehicle

Platinum Weekly newspaper | Rustenburg – Seven suspects were arrested and stolen property recovered following a police operation in the Bojanala Platinum area late last month. On 27 December 2025, members of the South African Police Service attached to Boitekong and Tlhabane Visible Policing, the Crime Combatting Unit, and the Phokeng K9 Unit acted on information that led them to the R510. There, police stopped a hijacked motor vehicle that was being towed and accompanied by two other vehicles.

According to warrant officer Ofentse Mokgadi, further investigation led officers to Tshenolo New Stand, where groceries believed to be stolen were recovered. The goods were valued at approximately R9,000.

Seven suspects were taken into custody in connection with the incident. They appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrate's Court on 30 December 2025, where the matter was postponed. The suspects were remanded in custody and are expected to return to court on 21 January 2026.

Across Wards 16 and 17, clean-up teams hit the ground running, proving once again that real community change doesn't come from talk alone, but from consistency, care, and boots on the ground. Led by André van Dyk, alongside Cllr Tanya Rothman, the EPWP team, fellow councillors, and dedicated volunteers, *Our Ward Matters* began the year with visible, hands-on interventions that tackled litter, overgrowth, illegal dumping, and neglected public spaces head-on.

A Strong Start: Ward 17 Clean-Up | 5 January 2026

On Wednesday, 7 January, *Our Ward Matters*, under the supervision of Cllr Tanya Rothman and Michael Rothman,

continued clean-up efforts in the Rivers area. Work focused on Timbati Veld and Usuturivier Ave, where recent heavy rains had caused severe overgrowth. Teams cut grass and cleared storm drains, improving safety and water flow. While good progress was made, further work is still needed as gardens and trees require ongoing attention.

Residents are encouraged to support OWM, as donations help cover essential daily costs such as petrol and equipment.

Safety Concerns Highlighted | 12 January 2026

On 12 January, OWM focused on the corner of Kruger Street and Wildevy Avenue, next to Rustenburg Baptiste Kerk. Overgrown vegetation has created hiding spots for criminals, posing a serious safety risk for residents using Kruger Bridge and nearby routes. Across the road near Wildevy Centrum, residents have raised concerns about squatters, drug activity, and public drinking. The clean-up was supported by Cllr Tanya Rothman, Cllr Jean Keyser, Cllr Martin Coetzee, and Youth Leader Michael Rothman.

Additional efforts included clearing Tamarisk Avenue near the open park, removing grass from the roadway, cutting overgrown areas, and taking down illegal advertising from trees in both Tamarisk and Wildevy Avenues.


