Rioolafval & Vrot Vleis in Drink Water



Brits – Volgens die VF+ loop Brits oor van die rioolafval en vrot vleis wat die dorp se drinkwater besoedel en die munisipaliteit doen niks daaraan nie (26 April 2011). Volgens mnr. Wynand van Wyk, plaaslike takvoorsitter van die party, sukkel die dorp al die afgelope vier jaar met verstopte rioolpype en oorspoelde mangate wat rioolafval oral in Brits laat opdam.

Die rioolafval beland in stormwatervore wat na riviere en strome afspoel en dit erg besoedel. Die munisipaliteit het ondanks herhaaldelike klagtes tot dusver weinig gedoen om die probleem op te los, het Van Wyk gesê. Daarby spoel 'n nabygeleë slagpale glo stukkie afval by die dreine af wat saam met die rioolafval in die water beland. "Die rioolpype verstopt en die rioolafval en vleis vloei uit die mangate in ons strome en uiteindelik in die Krokodilrivier waaruit ons drinkwater kom." Volgens mnr. Eddie Barlow,

DA-raadslid van die Madibeng-munisipaliteit (wat onder meer Brits bedien), is 65 sake reeds teen die gewese munisipale bestuurder aanhangig gemaak weens die besoedeling van die Krokodilrivier die afgelope twee jaar. Barlow het self twee jaar gelede 'n monster van die water geneem en dit laat ontleed. Volgens hom was die uitslae skrikwekkend.

Mnr. Peter Kin, 'n inwoner van Primindia wat oorkant die ontspanningsplek woon, het vertel die rioolafval stoot soms tot by sy voordeur op. "Soms lê dit vir drie weke hier voordat iemand dit kom skoonmaak. Die reuk is ondraaglik." Barlow meen die rede vir die oorstrooming is dat die rioolstelsel baie oud is. Hy het egter verseker die watersuiweringsaanleg is in goeie werkende toestand en drinkwater is dus skoon. Barlow is ook bekommerd oor die uitwerking wat besoedelde water op boere se besproeiingstelsels het.

Corpse found on N3



Heidelberg – According to North West Police, a man's decomposing body was found "sitting upright" next to the N3 in Heidelberg on Wednesday afternoon, 27 April 2011.

"The body was badly decomposed and could have been there for three weeks or more," said Captain Shado Mashobane. The body appeared to be that of a man in his 60s. Apparently members of a maintenance crew found the body propped up against a tree at 2.45pm, Mashobane said. He also commented that the cause of death was not immediately apparent.
