Rustenburg – "Church4bikers" originally came into existence on the 25th of May 2009, with their first service held at the PPK church in Piet Grobler Street, Rustenburg. From thereon, a service was held every second week at 16h00 the afternoon. Bikers from all over were very enthusiastic to attend and it became so popular that services were consequently scheduled on a weekly basis. However, the spark did not last very long and the numbers soon started to decrease. In response, Pst Sakkie and his wife Desiree Holtzhausen soon questioned themselves, "What were we doing wrong?" They have prayed about it and received an answer. "After a few months of services at the church, our vision and mission changed as we were lead by the Spirit of God." Pst Sakkie further added, "We wanted to do as the Gospel teaches us, to go out and make disciples. Therefore we decided not to be bound to a building but rather to go out, ride with our biker friends and have our services every time at a different venue. This we have been doing for more than a year and it has been very successful. A service attract between 60-90 bikers at a time

and the testimonies we have received of the changes that has taken place in peoples' lives through this ministry cannot be bought with money. We want to give God the glory for the way He has led us into moving into His complete will for this ministry, without Him we are nothing." On a more practical note, in future Church4-Bikers will also accommodate children where a trained children's church teacher that will be teaching the children during the service. Furthermore, the next church run will be held on the 29th of May. This run will also focus on the two years of existence of Church4Bikers. We will get together at the Rudan Garage at 08h15 and leave at 08h30, destination: Steinbech Lodge (service at 10am). After the service we want to invite EVERY-ONE for our spitbraai. 

Joy in Forgiveness of Israel's Sins

¹ Praise the LORD! Oh, give thanks to the LORD, for *He is good!* For His mercy *endures* forever. ² Who can utter the mighty acts of the LORD? Who can declare all His praise? ³ Blessed *are* those who keep justice, *And he who does righteousness* at all times! ⁴ Remember me, O LORD, with the favor *You have toward* Your people. Oh, visit me with Your salvation, ⁵ That I may see the benefit of Your chosen ones, That I may rejoice in the gladness of Your nation, That I may glory with Your inheritance. ⁶ We have sinned with our fathers, We have committed iniquity, We have done wickedly. ⁷ Our fathers in Egypt did not understand Your wonders; They did not remember the multitude of Your mercies, But rebelled by the sea—the Red Sea. ⁸ Nevertheless He saved them for His name's sake, That He might make His mighty power known. ⁹ He rebuked the Red Sea also, and it dried up; So He led them through the depths, As through the wilderness. ¹⁰ He saved them from the hand of him who *hated* them, And redeemed them from the hand of the enemy. ¹¹ The waters covered their enemies; There was not one of them left. ¹² Then they believed His words; They sang His praise. ¹³ They soon forgot His works; They did not wait for His counsel, ¹⁴ But lusted exceedingly in the wilderness, And tested God in the desert. ¹⁵ And He gave them their request, But sent leanness into their soul. ¹⁶ When they envied Moses in the camp, *And Aaron the saint of the LORD,* ¹⁷ The earth opened up and swallowed Dathan, And covered the faction of Abiram. ¹⁸ A fire was kindled in their company; The flame burned up the wicked. ¹⁹ They made a calf in Horeb, And worshiped the molded image. ²⁰ Thus they changed their glory; Into the image of an ox that eats grass. ²¹ They forgot God their Savior, Who had done great things in Egypt, ²² Wondrous works in the land of Ham, Awesome things by the Red Sea. ²³ Therefore He said that He would destroy them, Had not Moses His chosen one stood before Him in the breach, To turn away His wrath, lest He destroy *them.* ²⁴ Then they despised the pleasant land; They did not believe His word, ²⁵ But complained in their tents, *And did not heed the voice of the LORD.*

²⁶ Therefore He raised His hand *in an oath* against them, To overthrow them in the wilderness, ²⁷ To overthrow their descendants among the nations, And to scatter them in the lands. ²⁸ They joined themselves also to Baal of Peor, And ate sacrifices made to the dead. ²⁹ Thus they provoked *Him* to anger with their deeds, And the plague broke out among them. ³⁰ Then Phinehas stood up and intervened, And the plague was stopped. ³¹ And that was accounted to him for righteousness; To all generations forevermore. ³² They angered *Him* also at the waters of strife, So that it went ill with Moses on account of them; ³³ Because they rebelled against His Spirit, So that he spoke rashly with his lips. ³⁴ They did not destroy the peoples, Concerning whom the LORD had commanded them, ³⁵ But they mingled with the Gentiles; And learned their works; ³⁶ They served their idols, Which became a snare to them. ³⁷ They even sacrificed their sons; And their daughters to demons, ³⁸ And shed innocent blood, The blood of their sons and daughters, Whom they sacrificed to the idols of Canaan; And the land was polluted with blood. ³⁹ Thus they were defiled by their own works, And played the harlot by their own deeds. ⁴⁰ Therefore the wrath of the LORD was kindled against His people, So that He abhorred His own inheritance. ⁴¹ And He gave them into the hand of the Gentiles, And those who hated them ruled over them. ⁴² Their enemies also oppressed them, And they were brought into subjection under their hand. ⁴³ Many times He delivered them; But they rebelled in their counsel, And were brought low for their iniquity. ⁴⁴ Nevertheless He regarded their affliction, When He heard their cry; ⁴⁵ And for their sake He remembered His covenant, And relented according to the multitude of His mercies. ⁴⁶ He also made them to be pitied; By all those who carried them away captive. ⁴⁷ Save us, O LORD our God, And gather us from among the Gentiles, To give thanks to Your holy name, To triumph in Your praise. ⁴⁸ Blessed be the LORD God of Israel; From everlasting to everlasting! And let all the people say, "Amen!" Praise the LORD!
