


# Man hit by Train

**Potchefstroom** – The Khuma Police opened an Inquest Doc and is currently investigating a case after a victim died after allegedly being run over by a railway repair unit on Monday, 23 May 2011 at approximately 11h05. It is alleged that the driver of the railway repair unit was driving along the railway track behind extension eight of Khuma, on its way from Potchefstroom to Khutsong, when he encountered two men crossing the railway track. According to information received, the driver continued to hoot at the men in order for them to move out of the way. It is further alleged that once the driver passed the two men, he saw the victim, an African Female, Mama Sekhamane, aged 26 years, lying across the railway line. He allegedly did not attempt to not drive right over her. She died on the scene. **The investigation continues.**

# When Trucks & Cars Collide

**Orkney** – A man was killed and another was critically injured when the bakkie they were travelling in was hit by a heavy goods truck on the R30 between Orkney and Bothaville on Wednesday, 25 May 2011.

The cause of the accident and series of events leading up to it remain unclear and will form the subject of a South African Police Force investigation. Paramedics arrived at the scene only to find that the bakkie had emerged from a side road and turned into the path of the truck. The heavy goods vehicles slammed

into the bakkie and pushed it from the intersection. One man sustained critical injuries and died prior to the arrival of medics. His counterpart was fighting for his life and was heavily entrapped in the wreckage of the bakkie. Paramedics worked restlessly to stabilise him while fire-fighters used the Jaws of Life to cut him free. Once freed, he was treated and stabilised at the scene before he was rushed to a nearby hospital for the urgent medical care that he required. The driver of the truck was uninjured in the accident.
