Skoliere hou hoof as gyselaar, GOOI KLIPPE

Mafikeng - Leerlinge aan die Romaine-hoërskool naby Mafikeng kon vandeeweek nie hul eksamen in wiskundige gelettertheid en fisiese wetenskap aflê nie weens onluste waartydens die hoof as gyselaar aangehou is (15 Junie 2011).

Mnr. Gershwin Chuenyane, woordvoerder van Noordwes se onderwysdepartement, het gister gesê Gr. 8-, 9- en 10-leerlinge wat nie kon skryf nie, die eksamen wel sal aflê op 'n datum wat nog bepaal moet word. Volgens hom het leerlinge mnr. Bruce Molosiwa, die skoolhoof, Maandag as

gyselaar aangehou en geëis dat hy van die skool verwyder word. Die leerlinge beweer Molosiwa het 'n leerling van die skool Saterdag by 'n ander leerling se begrafnis in die Madibe-nedersetting naby Mafikeng aangerand.

Die polisie moes die skool se hoofhek oopbreek om in te kom en die hoof te bevry. Volgens Chuenyane het die leerlinge skoolruite en die hoof se kantoor met klippe bestook. Traangas is gebruik om die leerlinge te beheer.
