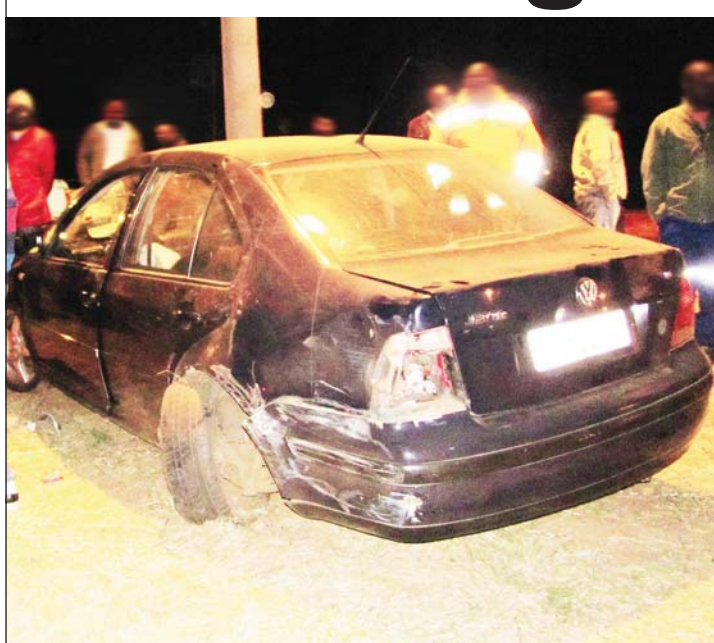
# Man flees after pushing bakkie over Bridge

**Rustenburg** – Thursday evening (16 June 2011) was met with chaos when a car collided with a bakkie on a bridge near Tuin Street on the old Marikana Road.



Apparently, the driver of an Opel came racing up the bridge and hit a Mazda Drifter until it tilted over the edge of the bridge and landed in a field next to the road. It is alleged that the driver of the Opel “ran away” before medical personnel arrived on scene. This accident occurred approximately 19h15 and the Police are currently investigating the accident. The driver of the bakkie (only occupant) sustained serious injuries and was stabilised on scene before being taken to the Peglerae Hospital. He is currently in a stable condition.

# Road Rage!



**Rustenburg** – The driver of an Opel Astra and a VW Jetta was involved in an accident on the old Swartuggens Road running past Tlhabane, close to the BP Garage. This collision occurred at approximately 19h00 on Saturday evening, the 18th of June 2011.

the two cars collided. The cause of the accident is unknown at this stage, but it is believed that road rage played a part. According to an eyewitness on scene, the Jetta pushed the Astra from the road.

What was described as “road rage” by bystanders resulted in a nasty traffic jam. Apparently both vehicles was travelling in the same direction, nose to nose, when the driver of the Astra tried to create “space” for the Jetta in his lane, as he wanted to change to the right-hand lane. The traffic was already frenzied and

The two occupants of the Astra, husband and wife, sustained injuries. The female sustained possible neck, back and head injuries. She was stabilised on scene before transported to the Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital. The two occupants of the Jetta sustained no injuries. **The SAPS is currently investigating the accident.**



# 4 Severely Hurt in Car Crash

**Rustenburg** – On Saturday night, the 18th of June 2011, a Golf was involved in an accident which bears no apparent cause. “We have no idea from which direction the Golf came,” one of the emergency personnel on scene said. Just before the

Rustenburg Jail (R510), the driver lost control over his vehicle, swerved off the road and overturned a couple of times. Speed is suspected to be the main cause of the accident at this stage; however, the Police are investigating the circumstances of

the accident. The four occupants of the Golf were seriously injured. They were stabilised on scene before being taken to the Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital. They sustained severe, multiple fractures as well as head injuries.
