Ambulance involved in accident

Phokeng/ Rustenburg – On Saturday night, around 22h30, a Royal Bafokeng Ambulance (VW) transporting a woman with labour pains and a Toyota Corolla were involved in a collision.

Both vehicles were travelling in the same direction [Rustenburg] on the main road through Phokeng, when they collided close to the Bafokeng Stadium. The ambulance transported the pregnant lady to hospital to give birth.

According to eye witnesses on scene, the Toyota allegedly did not want to give right of way to the ambulance when he tried to overtake the Toyota. In the process the two vehicles ‘scarcely touched’ but it still led to the vehicles veering off the road uncontrollably.

Fortunately no one was hurt during the accident and at time of going to print it was confirmed that neither the pregnant lady, nor the unborn baby, sustained any injuries at all.

The SAPS are currently investigating the accident. They would also like to take this opportunity to make road users more aware of the fact that emergency vehicles have right of way. You can actually be issued with a ticket for not moving out of the way. The rule book for drivers licences state that you must at all times be able to hear and see emergency vehicles and that you should give right of way to emergency vehicles. Remember, make way for an ambulance with flashing lights and sirens – when a life is on the line, every second counts!
