

Crematorium reconstruction underway

Rustenburg – Representatives of the Rustenburg Local Municipality and some members of the South African Police Services (SAPS) managed to stop the complete destruction of a crematorium following vandalism by thieves, who had forced their way into the premises. A case of theft has been opened at the SAPS. Speaking to The Platinum Weekly, Mrs. Daleen Jordaan – who is a co-owner of the crematorium together with Mrs. Josselyn Geldenhuis – was hopeful that the crematorium would open its doors by 1 August 2011.

She said she has been working tirelessly to ensure that the crematorium starts operating again and is thankful to all the people who have been praying for the success of the reconstruction exercise. "Our crematorium is opening again through literally staying on our knees and hundreds of people

praying for us," said Mrs. Jordaan. According to information made available to the Platinum Weekly, the fence on the side of the building was removed while the garage-type doors were forced open and also removed.

With the help of a crane, the oven was removed from the building and was already outside the building when Mrs Jordaan was alerted by her mother, who happened to be driving past and saw what was happening. Mrs Jordaan, together with the SAPS and representatives of the Local Municipality, rushed to the Crematorium and immediately stopped the perpetrators from further damaging the oven and structure and forced them to leave the premises open. A considerable amount of work has already been

done in order to make sure that the crematorium is restored to its former glory. However, a lot more still needs to be done due to the extensive damage that has been inflicted to the roof of the structure and doors of the building as a result of the forceful removal of the oven by the previous owners, Mr Leon Lombaard and Danie Du Toit. The cost of the repairing is expected to be considerably high as a number of items will need to be replaced.

At the time of the liquidation on 13 May 2010, most of the furniture inside the building was removed and now needs to be replaced at a very high cost. The fridges are also in a terrible state after they were disassembled and left on a heap inside the building. Mrs. Jordaan is hopeful that the damage can be fixed soon and remains confident that the crematorium can again be up and running before 1 August 2011.



Do you know these men? Moses Phakoe Killers

Rustenburg – The South African Police Services (SAPS) is requesting for assistance in the identification of the men shown in these pictures. Police believe that they may be able to assist them in the murder case of the late Rustenburg councillor, Moses Phakoe, who was shot and killed at his Rustenburg home in 2009.

The murder took place on Saturday, 14 March 2009 at about 20h00, but the people behind the crime are yet to be apprehended – more than two years after the incident took place. Cllr Phakoe was shot and killed at his residential address in Rustenburg by unknown suspect(s). The deceased was driving his BMW motor

vehicle when attacked in his drive way while he was coming back from putting up campaign posters for President Jacob Zuma before the 2009 Presidential elections.

Anyone who may recognise the men on the picture, or who might have seen them, to please contact the investigating officer Warrant Officer Mathope at 014 565 9141 or 082 773 0908. At the time of his death, Phakoe had become prominent for his zero tolerance towards corruption. This stance had made him very unpopular within some ranks of the ANC and observers believe that this is what ultimately led to his death. Police believe that the murder of Cllr Phakoe was politically motivated.
