## 7% Share Drop for Merafe Resources

**Kroondal** – The falling of shares in the JSE-listed Merafe Resources fell by 7.9% on Wednesday after the company said its interim earnings would drop and that its chrome venture with Xstrata would operate at 50% of its capacity until August.

The capacity of the venture has slowed down from its previous 65% during the winter months of June to August when Merafe does routine maintenance.

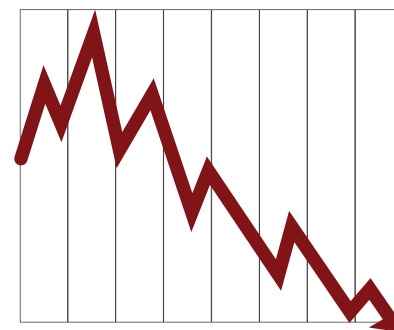
In a statement, Merafe said the revised production plans were "due to current market conditions". Merafe revealed that the European benchmark for ferrochrome had been set at \$1.20/lb for the third quarter, which is a decrease of 11% from the previous quarter's \$1.35/lb and 4% lower than the first-quarter price of \$1.25/lb.

This was as a result of the falling demand from stainless steel makers. Merafe – which will publish its financial results for the past six months on August 2 – says it expects lower earnings.

According to the company's forecasts, earnings a share and headline earnings a share would be between 3c and 4c, compared with earnings of 8c a share and headline earnings of 7c a share during the same period last year.

The shares of the Johannesburg-based Merafe dropped to R1.05, a share after it issued the trading update, but traded at R1.10 a share by late morning. The Merafe-Xstrata joint venture has a capacity of 1.98-million tons of ferrochrome each year, supplying around 16% of the world's ferrochrome requirements.

Shareholders of the company are referred to the SENS announcement on 4 May 2011 in which Merafe indicated that various furnaces will undergo routine maintenance during the winter months of June to August 2011.
