It is a combination of traditional sounds from the caves that they lived in.” These are the words of Lucky Vincent, a musician based in the North West who is fast making a name for himself in South Africa. Born in 1980 on June 12, Lucky Vincent Motshwari says

his upbringing in the North West countryside lifestyle - herdboys, domestic farming, folklore and traditional song, developed him into a vibrant pianist with folk melodies. “There are four of us in our family. I am the only one who is a musician. I went to school in Johannesburg,” he said. Since studying music at East Side College in 2001, he has become a composer, pianist and lead vocalist. Motshwari has played alongside giants like Bheki Khoza, Tlokwe Sehume, McCoy Mrubata and many other artists during his travels to Botswana, Algeria, Zimbabwe and Zambia. His band is composed of bassist Jimmy Baloyi, drummer Mike Motshupi, saxophonist George Gaompotse, and guitarist Shell Taukobong.
