Purpose

Section 25 (1) of the Municipal Systems Act, 2000 prescribes that "each municipal council must, within a prescribed period after the start of its elected term, adopt a single, inclusive and strategic plan for the development of the municipality". Section 28 (1) of the same Act also prescribes that a municipal council within a prescribed period after the start of its elected term, must adopt a process set out writing to guide the planning, drafting, adoption and review of its integrated development plan (IDP).

As adhere to the quoted sections, council approved the IDP, Budget and PMS process plan in the ordinary council meeting of June 2011. This is the first phase that will lead to the development of a five year IDP that will inform the developments over the term of the current council.
