Carjackers targeting bakkies in RTB

Rustenburg – “Motorists should not stop for unknown passengers when they are travelling. This increases their chances of being hijacked.” This was the stern warning from North West SAPS spokesperson Lieutenant Colonel Metsi in the wake of a number of carjacking reports in Rustenburg (10 August 2011).
The suspects, who are targeting bakkies, lure their unsuspecting victims to a secluded area where they leave them stranded after forcing them out of their vehicles before driving away. One of the four Isuzu bakkies hijacked earlier in Rustenburg was found abandoned by the suspects in Soshanguve, east of Pretoria early this week. In Tlhabane, three suspects were arrested after they were caught driving a stolen mo-

tor vehicle. On Friday 4 August 2011 at about 01h00, police in the area received information from a vehicle-tracking company concerning a stolen white Toyota Hilux. The tracking signal led police to the corner of Burn and Johnson streets in Rustenburg North.
Upon arrival, the Police arrested the three suspects. Two of the suspects were found inside the vehicle, while the third was found at a nearby tavern.
According to police investigations, the vehicle was hijacked last month at Boitekong in Rustenburg. The trio, two men and one woman, aged between 24 and 29 are due to appear in court on charges of possession of suspected stolen property and armed robbery with aggravated circumstances.

“I don't feel SAFE in Rustenburg anymore”

Rustenburg – Driving alone at night is no longer a safe excursion in Rustenburg, especially for women. On the evening of Sunday August 7, a 37-year-old woman experienced a smash-and-grab when her handbag with cash and important documents was snatched by a gun-wielding thief, when he broke her passenger seat window. She, travelling in her white Tata, stopped at the red lights at the Shell Garage on her way to the Waterfall Mall when the unthinkable occurred. The incident occurred at around 20h30. According to details made available to the Platinum Weekly, the woman was coming from a local Church when she stopped at an ATM at the garage and withdrew some money. A man wearing dark clothes, who had been monitoring her movements, smashed the window of the car and grabbed the handbag before taking off into the night. A sum of about R1 200 was inside the handbag as well as an ID document, driver's licence and a cellular phone. Although the woman was not injured, she was traumatised by the ordeal. In an interview she said, “I do not feel safe in Rustenburg anymore. These thieves must be put to justice.” SAPS are currently investigating the case.
