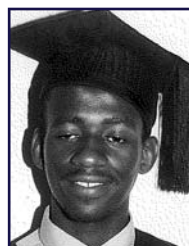

HELP US FIGHT CRIME



Freak Accident

Phokeng/ Rustenburg – The driver of a Mitsubishi Fuso haulage truck tragically died during a freak accident which occurred on Wednesday August 10 at around 9h15 at a roundabout linking the new Sun City- and the Phokeng Roads.

According to eyewitnesses, the driver lost control of the vehicle as he approached the roundabout. The truck then went over the roundabout and through the barriers before the driver was ejected through the windscreen upon impact with the barriers. "The truck ran over him and the driver was killed," said an eyewitness. The driver, who was travelling without any passengers, died due to multiple trauma injuries. Through collaboration of paramedics and the Fire Department, they used airbags to lift the front of the truck before pulling the man's body from underneath the truck. Police suspect that the driver, who was transporting a huge load of sand, was either not wearing his safety belt or decided to remove it during the course of the accident to try and escape. The SAPS are still investigating.

When bikes and cars collide...

Rustenburg – Two people travelling on a motorbike, allegedly under the influence of alcohol, crashed into a VW Golf in an accident that occurred in Boom Street on Friday evening, August 12 at around 19h15.

According to eyewitnesses, the driver of the Golf – travelling in front of the motorbike – indicated his intentions of turning to the left, to enter his residence. "Instead of overtaking on the right side, the motorcyclist driver chose to go to the left and this is what caused the accident," said an eyewitness.

After crashing into the car, the motorcyclist was flung through the air and landed about 20 meters from the scene of the accident.

Paramedics stabilized the motorcyclist who sustained a broken sternum (chest bone) and transported him to the Job Shi-

mankana Tabane Hospital for treatment. The driver of the Golf and the passenger of the motorbike sustained no injuries.



Three injured in accident



Rustenburg – One person sustained serious injuries in an accident involving three vehicles, which occurred on Monday August 15 at around 18h30 at the Bakwena N1 N4 (Marikana) toll gate. According to eye witnesses, the accident occurred as the driver of a Ford was paying his toll fees at the toll gate, when a small Kia truck travelling from Pretoria's direction crashed into a VW that was behind the Ford. The impact of the crash triggered a chain reaction which saw the VW crashing into the Ford.

The driver of the truck sustained minor injuries and abrasions while his passenger sustained potential head- and spinal injuries as well as very serious facial lacerations (cuts). They were transported to the Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital for treatment. The two women travelling in the VW sustained potential spinal injuries and were transported to Peglerae Hospital while the people in the Ford were not injured during the accident.

"The scene was very chaotic and the lane had to be closed for several hours after the accident," said an eyewitness.

SAPS are carrying out further investigations.

Accident Culprit Flees the Scene



Rustenburg – Police in Rustenburg are looking for a man who abandoned an accident scene after allegedly causing the accident on Sunday 14 August at around 10h45 on the corner of Loop Street and Nelson Mandela Drive.

According to eyewitnesses, the driver of a green BMW had the right of way [green light] and was turning into Nelson Mandela Drive when an unknown vehicle came from ABSA Bank's direction, skipped a red light and crashed into the BMW.

"The driver of the other vehicle immediately fled the scene. Other motorists tried to pursue him but they could not catch up to him," said an eye witness.

An elderly married couple was travelling in the BMW. Paramedics stabilised both of them on scene, and it is suspected that the lady sustained neck injuries. "The woman was taken to hospital by her family members. The man who was travelling with her was fine," said the eyewitness. The SAPS, who are allegedly in possession of the registration number of the vehicle that fled the scene, are currently investigating the case.
