Lonmin Scores an Industry Safety Record

Police HUNT copper thieves...

Rustenburg – Police in the North West have intensified their hunt to bring to book copper thieves operating in the area.

"A number of operations are currently running throughout the province and we are eager to arrest as many people illegally dealing in copper as possible," said Lt Col Lesego Metsi of SAPS in North West.

Furthermore, the price of copper is likely to remain high over the next 12 months even as commodity prices fall on worries of a global economic slowdown, First Quantum Minerals president Clive Newall said on Monday. He added that due to a fragile world economy, all commodity prices would be volatile over the next 12 months, with a higher likelihood of dropping.

"However, copper is an increasingly scarce element with ever rising costs of production and no signs of any significant new substitution possibilities," he said.

Copper cable theft costs the South African economy an estimated R10bn a year. Copper is widely available, poorly secured and easy to steal due to the extensive power and communications networks of Transnet, Eskom and Telkom.

It is also easy to sell. There are thousands of scrap dealers or "bucket shops" willing to trade in illicit copper.
