

Wesizwe appoints new FD

Platinum exploration and development company Wesizwe reported on Monday that Wenilang Ma, from the Chinese group Jinchuan, would take over from Jacques de Wet as the company's financial director. De Wet would remain with the company in an advisory capacity (22 August 2011). Jinchuan and the China Africa Development Fund provided the aspiring

platinum miner with equity funding of \$227-million in exchange for a 45% stake, as well as a project finance facility of \$650-million.

The company also announced that its corporate affairs director Mlibo Mgudlwa had resigned. Mgudlwa would continue to serve on Wesizwe's board as a nonexecutive director.

NW Court officials suspended

Rustenburg – Eleven officers from the Department of Justice have been suspended for allegedly defrauding the department's maintenance courts in the North West Province.

The employees were linked to a syndicate that allegedly defrauded the government of R500 000 in child maintenance support. The officials were implicated at the Swartruggens and the Bafokeng Magistrate's Court near Rustenburg.

Investigations by internal auditors revealed that state funds were deposited into false bank accounts. The justice department's Tsietsi Malema said three of the officials resigned, but charges would still be laid against them.

While the department said more officers could be suspended, police in the North West say they are waiting for the completion of that probe to start their own investigations.
