


## 1 Week = 2 Deaths @ Impala & Anglo, Rustenburg

### Miner killed at Impala 20#

Rustenburg – A miner was killed by a fall of ground at Impala Platinum 20# in Rustenburg, the National Union of Mineworkers (NUM) said. The miner who was killed on the morning of the 30th of August, was a contractor working for Murray and Roberts.

Impala has halted work at this shaft.

"The NUM passes its condolences to the family and friends of the deceased and calls upon the membership to observe a day of mourning," said spokesman Lesiba Seshoka of NUM. This most recent death encouraged the union in its plans to organise a national day of mourning on October 4 for mineworkers killed in the workplace.

Seshoka said the Department of Mineral Resources should divulge which mining companies had the worst safety records.

Department spokesman Bheki Khumalo said NUM was being "disingenuous", as the union were supplied with the relevant statistics monthly. He added that they would not reveal the details of the worst mines when it comes to safety as the mines are listed on the Johannesburg Securities Exchange and doing so would harm share prices. "We can say though that most fatalities are in the gold and platinum sector," he said.

At time of going to print Impala Platinum was not available for comment.

### Death at Anglo

Rustenburg – On this tainted Tuesday, a worker of Anglo's Rustenburg operations was reported missing (he failed to clock out). On Wednesday 31 August, he was found dead at the level 29 haulage, between the boundary of the Khomanani 2 and the Siphumelele 1 shafts.

The cause of death is not yet known, a spokesperson for Anglo said.

The NUM called for an immediate issue of a Section 54 notice.

These deaths bring the number of deaths in South Africa's mining sector to 93 so far for 2011.
