Obey Stop Signs!

Rustenburg – Failing to obey a stop sign resulted in an accident at the intersection of Foord and Benoni Street in Rustenburg on Friday August 26 at around 7h45.

According to eyewitnesses, a taxi travelling in Benoni Street ignored a stop sign and crashed into a VW Golf, which had right of way at the intersection. Apparently the VW was travelling in Foord Street towards Nelson Mandela Avenue.

“The impact of the collision caused the Golf to crash into a tree. Luckily there were no major injuries and all occupants from both vehicles emerged unharmed,” said an eyewitness.

SAPS are carrying out further investigations.



Oh-oh, You're in Trouble...

Rustenburg – An impatient driver who was towing a VW Golf learnt the hard way why it is important to obey traffic lights when he was involved in an accident which occurred at the intersection of Thabo Mbeki Drive and Oliver Tambo Way on Friday 26 August 2011 at around 21h30.

According to eyewitnesses, the driver of the vehicle that was towing the Golf skipped a red traffic light and caused a collision with a Mitsubishi truck.

What's more, “The driver of then immediately unhooked the VW and fled the scene. Police are still looking for the person,” said the eyewitness.

SAPS – who are investigating the case – have established that the VW Golf had no number plates and that the license disc on its windscreen is fake.

Faulty 'Robots' Cause Crash

Rustenburg – Faulty traffic lights at the intersection of Fatima Bhayat and Steen Streets were blamed for an accident which occurred on Saturday August 27 at around 6h30.

According to eyewitnesses, the collision between a Nissan Diesel delivery truck and a Toyota Corolla Conquest took place after both vehicles attempted to proceed at the same time. “The accident took place due to the faulty traffic lights. The truck turned and ended up in front of the Toyota which caused the crash,” said an eyewitness. SAPS arrived at the scene fifteen minutes after the accident.

Fortunately the three people travelling in the Toyota and the driver of the truck were not seriously injured and emerged from the accident with minor bumps and bruises.
