

Another cop killed, Stabbed to Death

Lichtenburg/ Itsoseng – A police officer was stabbed to death outside his home in Itsoseng, near Lichtenburg, police have revealed. Police spokesperson Brigadier Ngubane said 50-year-old police sergeant, Keneiwe Seleke, left his house on Friday night to walk to his brother's house, four blocks away, when he was attacked.

"Seleke's son heard his father screaming outside. When he went outside the house to inspect, he saw three suspects running away from the scene. He stumbled upon his father, lying in the street with a stab wound to his stomach," said Ngubane.

Consequently, the son took his father to the Itsoseng health centre where he was unfortunately declared dead upon arrival. Police suspect that the three men who killed Seleke were robbing him. Sergeant Seleke has dedicated 19 years of his life, in protecting, defending, and saving the lives of the defenseless.

Through intensive investigations by the Hawks, they managed to arrest three suspects, all of them 19 years of age on Tuesday, the 30th of August 2011. During the arrest the Police recovered a pair of scissors, covered in blood, believed to have been used in stabbing of Sgt Seleke. All suspects will appear in the Itsoseng Magistrate Court on Thursday, the 1st of September 2011. No updates were available at the time of going to press.
