## AngloGold reports death of injured worker



**Orkney** – A shift boss who was injured in an accident at the Kopanang mine near Orkney just over two months ago, has passed away, gold miner AngloGold Ashanti said on Thursday (1 September 2011). The worker was engulfed by a rockslide of fine ore during the construction of a safety canopy in a waste silo at the mine on June 26. He died on Wednesday, the company reported.
