### Medical Aid Details

Most private medical facilities do not accept patients if they don't have a medical aid. In the unfortunate case of a medical emergency, valuable time is saved if your medical aid details are readily available. It is therefore important that when you travel your family's medical aid details are easily accessible to anyone. Also important: You MUST at ALL times have contact numbers of your friends and family in your vehicle, or at least

some form of identification. In distressing circumstances e.g. an accident, emergency personnel will not know who to contact if no information is available.

### Packing Your First Aid Kit

Your travelling first aid kit is a comfort box and an emergency kit in one. It needs to be stocked with everyday medication as well as the items needed to treat minor injuries. One should always make sure that any personal, special medication such as insulin is suitably packed and ready to go along with you. Phone Trauma Rescue at 0861 789 911 to order one.

## 13 injured in accident

**Rustenburg** – Thirteen people were injured, one of them seriously, when a bakkie allegedly turned into the lane of a taxi on the Thabazimbi R510 Road. The accident occurred just 10km outside Rustenburg at around 11h00.

According to eyewitnesses, a passenger in the bakkie sustained serious head injuries, which was bleeding profusely from a deep laceration (cut).

The other twelve people – who were in the taxi – were also rushed to hospital to be treated for minor injuries. The SAPS are carrying out further investigations.



## Drinking... and Driving.



**Rustenburg** – A suspected drunken driver and three other passengers are lucky to be alive after the vehicle they were travelling in, rolled several times on the Buffelspoort Road on Saturday, September 10 at around 23h30.

The accident – which occurred just 30km from Rustenburg – resulted in one of the four men being rushed to hospital after sustaining serious spinal injuries. The other three were also taken to hospital to be treated for minor injuries.

The SAPS are investigating and suspect that the driver of the car was under the influence of alcohol.



## 2 die in head-on collision

**Rustenburg** – Two people lost their lives on Sunday 11 September when two vehicles were involved in a head-on collision on the Thabazimbi Road, 10 km from Rustenburg. This collision occurred at approximately 00h30.

According to an eyewitness, a BMW attempted to overtake two vehicles at once, which resulted in the collision with an Isuzu bakkie that was travelling in the opposite direction.

One person travelling in the BMW died after his neck was broken while the other occupants of the BMW was rushed to hospital by paramedics.

One person travelling in the Isuzu also died upon impact while his colleague sustained neck injuries and was transported to a nearby hospital for treatment. The SAPS are carrying out further investigations.
