- ✓ Have a good financial record and banking account.
- ✓ A comprehensive constitution attached to the business plan, profile and executive/management structure .
- ✓ In operation/functional for at least two years or more than two years.
- ✓ Be in the possession of a letter from the tribal authority or the council that approves their operation (confirmation of a piece of land)

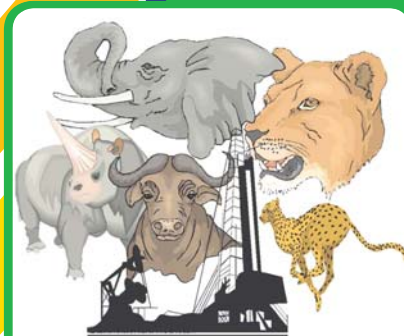
These organizations stated above should be in the possession of the following:

The Spring Show is Pretoria's biggest agricultural and lifestyle show, going strong since 1939. Held at the Tshwane Events Centre, it provides family entertainment, music, exhibitions and plenty of shopping opportunities, from camping gear to 4 x 4 equipment.

The show, which has grown in leaps and bounds over the years, has become the focal point of the agricultural sector in South Africa.

Bojanala Platinum District participated in the following categories: Best Stall, Best SMME and Best Cattle on show and made their mark! Bojanala Platinum District

Bramaan's Cattle Farming was on show for the prize, Best Cattle on show in its class.

The Spring Show in Tshwane is a great tourist attraction for the city and presents the SMMEs in Bojanala a once in a lifetime opportunity of showcasing their products and services to a wider and more diverse South African audience.

The Show's rich history originated before the Second World War in 1939, when farmers were exhibiting their produce in the old city hall in Pretorius Street.

After the war the produce was displayed on the lawns of the City Hall in Paul Kruger Street.

Lack of space forced the organizers to seek another venue and in 1954 the Pretoria Show moved to the current grounds in Pretoria West.
