Drill operator killed @ First Uranium mine



Westonaria – First Uranium said on Tuesday (13 September 2011) that an accident at its Ezulwini mine, on the outskirts of Westonaria, killed a drill operator, the fourth death at this South African mine in the last twelve months.

The Toronto-based uranium and gold producer said that operations have been halted until an investigation into the cause of the accident can be completed. Apparently the drill operator was killed by a 'fall of ground'; on the Number 50 level of the underground mine.

In August, the company said one man was killed in "an incident", which was under internal investigation. In March, a worker was killed by a fall of ground, while a tunnel collapse in November killed one worker and injured three others.

Shares of First Uranium closed unchanged at 38 Canadian cents on Tuesday on the Toronto Stock Exchange. The stock has slipped more than 72% since the beginning of this year.
