# Police officers awarded for bravery

**Rustenburg** – Agile and competent police officers – who prevented what could have been an armed robbery and murder in Tlhabane in 2008 – received awards from the SAPS in a move meant to encourage other law enforcement officers to follow in their footsteps.

On August 1, Const Molema, Sgt Sewparsad and Const Marais – who are stationed at the Rustenburg K9 (Dog) Unit – received a complaint of possible hostage and attempted armed robbery. After following the tracks of the suspects, the officers located them at house number 1209 at the corner of Katlego Crescent and Tshireletso Street in Tlhabane.

After breaking into the house, they heard a gunshot as one of the suspects decided to kill himself. The police officers managed to arrest the other men. The men arrested – who were detained at Tlhabane SAPS – were charged for attempted armed robbery and hostage.



# Businesses pledge to work together

**Rustenburg** – Various businesses based in the North West Province – who had converged under a single roof – were encouraged to work together in order to realize their goals during the launch of the Platinum Corridor Chamber of Businesses.

The launch, which was held at the Rustenburg Civic Centre on Wednesday 14 September, also saw the various businesses in the area exchanging ideas on how to ensure that as many of them as possible benefit from the mining opportunities in the Province.

# Major Drug Bust! 12 kg of Cristal Meth

**Hartbeespoortdam** – Five (5) suspects arrested for Housebreaking and Theft as well as for Possession of Suspected Stolen Property together with a preliminary investigation led to a major drug bust.

On Wednesday 14 September 2011 at around 09h00 a case of Housebreaking and Theft was registered and on the very same morning at around 10h00, five (5) suspects were arrested for Housebreaking and Possession of stolen property at the Caribbean Beach Estate in Hartbeespoortdam. One (1) 42 inch television set was recovered.

During preliminary investigations on the above matter, Hartbeespoortdam police received information that the suspects were also involved in a drug syndicate dealing in Crystal Methamphetamine. One suspect was booked out for investigation and taken to his premises where the police found approximately 12 kg of Cristal

Methamphetamine and one (1) 50 inch flat screen television set. The drugs and the television set were seized and taken to Hartbeespoortdam police for safekeeping.

A Case of Dealing in Drugs is under investigation. All Five (5) suspects aged between 22 and 46 are still in police custody and they are expected to appear before court soon.
