Banyana qualify for 2012 Olympics

Banyana Banyana booked their place as one of the two African nations that will compete at the 2012 London Olympics when they drew 1 – 1 against Ethiopia in the second leg fixture of the Olympic qualifier.

The match was played on a muddy pitch at the Addis Ababa National Stadium on Sunday, 11 September 2011. The South Africans came into the match with a 3-0 advantage after the first leg fixture played at the Orlando Stadium in Soweto on August 27, courtesy of three goals from striker Noko Matlou.

Playing in front of over 15 000 fans, the Ethiopians took the game to Banyana Banyana in the first half, but after a scoreless first 45 minutes, it was Nyandeni who crossed the ball from the left-hand side in the opening minute of the second period. Ethiopian goalkeeper Liya Shibru Ossa was made to

stretch high to collect the ball, and as she fell to the ground Banyana Banyana players protested that the ball had been held over the goal-line by the goalkeeper. After consulting with the assistant referee, the goal was awarded to take the visitors' score-line to 4-0 over the two matches.

Banyana Banyana head coach Joseph Mkhonza then made some tactical changes with Nothando Vilakazi replacing the tough-tackling Yola Jafta in midfield, while Mary Ntsweng was introduced in the centre of the park for captain Amanda Dlamini.

With 12 minutes remaining, Banyana Banyana found themselves two players down when Matlou and left-back defender Gabisile 'China' Hlumbane were receiving medical attention off the field. The Ethiopians seized the opportunity against the 9-person Banyana Banyana, and

Tibylin Mesfin Tameru fired home a shot from the edge of the penalty box to level the scores on the day. Matlou, who was closely marked and continuously tackled down into the mud throughout the match, was replaced by Sasol League National Championships Player's Player of the Tournament, midfielder Sanah Mollo late in the game. As the final whistle blew to signify the South African Senior Women's National team's qualification for the 2012 Olympic showpiece, the Banyana Banyana team put on their 'London Here We Come' T-shirts and ran towards the 150-odd South African supporters in the grandstand, chanting songs of celebration..

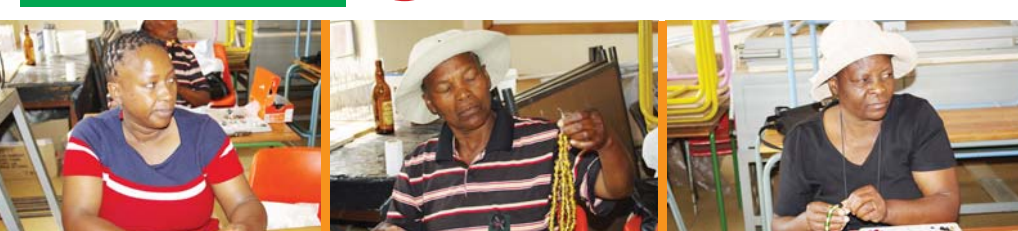

Unique Glass Beads

Rustenburg – Bojanala Platinum District Municipality has supported a bead-making project in Luka by donating machinery valued at R198 000 in a development that will go a long way in boosting the production of the enterprise.

The donation to "Unique Glass Beads" was made on Tuesday 13 September at Luka Villiage (Mogono Section) and was attended by the MMC for Local Economic Development (LED) in the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality, Cllr Welleminah Moleko, Cllr Philip Makhutle and Bojanala Platinum District Officials, Keitumetse Masemola, Thabo Mashomo and Andy Mabalane, who represented the Rustenburg Local Municipality (LED). "We will make sure that the machines are maintained from time to time and that they are being used properly," said Cllr Moleko. "We hope that through this support we will be able to help improve their production.

We also want to help them to market their products because according to our findings, lack of proper marketing has been a hindering factor," added Cllr Moleko. Unique Glass Beads was established in 2005 and currently employs five women who are involved in the making of necklaces, bangles, earrings and bracelets from beads made out of glass.

The equipment that was donated will help in making the beads. The pieces of glass are melted onto rods using a high temperature flame. Depending on the desired bead design, the glass is shaped while hot to the designer's required size and shape. All beads are individually made for perfection and are then used to make beautiful accessories in the form of necklaces, bracelets, earrings, key rings handbag charms etc.
