

**Rustenburg** – The trailer of a freight carrier truck was dislodged and plummeted onto the tarmac after the truck hit an overhead sign. This occurred along the Nelson Mandela Street on Monday September 19.

The falling trailer narrowly missed a small vehicle that was travelling behind the truck in an accident that did not result in any injuries.

The trailer – which was blocking traffic – had to be mechanically lifted and carried over the sign post before being re-engaged back onto the truck. Police officers – who were quickly called to the scene – dis-

covered that the driver of the truck was not in a possession of a permit that allows him to carry heavy loads.

Speaking to the Platinum Weekly, the driver – who was travelling from Pretoria – revealed that he frequently uses this route. "This is the third time that I am transporting a heavy load. I do not have a permit because my employers have not facilitated one for me. They just tell me to go," said the truck driver. When informed about the accident the owner of the truck, who was said to be in Cape Town, denied any responsibility.
