Rustenburg Kloof

The place to be this Summer!



Rustenburg – Are you the extrovert, adventurous, outdoor type of person – the kind that likes to explore a resort close to nature? Or would you rather lazily tan in the sun, maybe take a dip or two in a swimming pool (cold/ heated), and meet new friends? Or are you more of a cosy-nook, seeking a space where you can get away from the every-day hustle and bustle of the city and read a book or two... to quietly find your piece of mind again?

We have found the perfect spot for you! A visit to the Rustenburg Kloof Holiday Resort & Conference Centre can offer you just that, and so much more! Referred to as "The Kloof" by local residents, this break-away haven is one of the premier holiday destinations Rustenburg has to offer our Platinum city.

This well-known resort with its beautiful, scenic and peaceful surroundings forms part of the Magaliesberg Mountain Range. The Kloof offers a large caravan site with a number of chalets on the outskirts of town. The campsites have water taps, electric outlets and braai pits. Animals roam around the playgrounds, tennis courts, and swimming pools (with a water slide!). There is also a hiking trail to a nearby waterfall.

How do you get to the Kloof? It is quite easy to get there – from Rustenburg, head south on Bethlehem St (near the bus station) until the end of the road. Take a right onto Watsonian Rd (Brink Street becomes Watsonia Road at the corner of Bethlehem, (Fields Primary & NG Bergsig)) and continue for 2.5 km. Then turn left onto Dr. Moroka Drive and continue 1.5 km to the end of the road and then take a left and continue 100 m to the entrance gate on your right hand side. According to the Assistant Manager – Mr. Pieter Le Roux – the resort has facilities for accommodation, braai, budget accommodation, camping, caravan sites, chalets, hiking, hotel, lodge and sleeping. Accommodation prices range from R450 to R950 per night – depending on the type of accommodation – while camping sites range from R105 to R250. "We are open seven days a week, so this means that we are always accessible," said Pieter. For day visitors, the facility is open from 08h 00 to 17h 00. "On popular holidays such as Christmas Day or during Easter, we do not open to daily visitors. We do this so that we are able to adequately manage and cater for the people who would have booked accommodation during that period. We also host events for large groups of people for example - the Poison Rally where thousands of bikers come together. This is merely one of the numerous occasions we cater for. Our visitors are mostly South Africans from all over the country. They like to come here due to our competitive pricing," adds Pieter. "We have a total of 87 chalets and visitors can also make use of a kiosk and a bar. The main attraction to the Kloof is the location. We are a stone-throw away, and offer relaxing, natural surroundings... away from hectic schedules!"
