Crash Boom Bang!



Rustenburg – Approximately 15 kilometres from Rustenburg, a head-on collision occurred between a Toyota Corolla and a minibus on the Thabazimbi Road (R510), Boitekong Crossing. The accident occurred around 19h40 on the 8th of October 2011.

According to eye witnesses on scene, the Corolla was passing another vehicle, and subsequently collided with the oncoming Taxi. Police investigations are underway. Sixteen (16) individuals sustained various bumps and bruises, and in one case fractures were sustained. Emergency personnel on scene transported all the patients to different clinics and hospitals.



Chasing Pavements



lost control over his vehicle on the Bleskop Road, approximately 40km from Rustenburg. As a result, his vehicle swerved off the road before it uncontrollably started rolling into the bushes next to the road. This accident occurred on the 8th of October 2011, approximately 22h30 in the evening.

Rustenburg/ Bleskop – What could have been a horror accident, turned into two individuals being taken to hospital. Reckless driving is suspected. The driver of a white Nissan, allegedly under the influence of alcohol,

No other vehicles were involved and it is also suspected that the two occupants were not wearing any safety belts. The case is under investigation by the Police. The two occupants only sustained mild bumps and bruises and were transported to a nearby hospital for treatment.

Oops...

Rustenburg – “It was a dice between two vehicles.” an eye witness said. During the early morning hours of Sunday morning (00h45), 9 October 2011 this accident left one of the cars on its roof. This accident occurred on the R104 Swartruggens road, the robot at the Ferncrest hospital. It involved a grey Passat and red VW Polo.

The driver of the Passat only sustained bumps and bruises and were transported to Ferncrest. The condition of the Polo's driver is unknown at this stage. The Police are currently investigating this case.



2 injured in car collision

Rustenburg – Two people sustained injuries after their cars collided on the N4, about 8km from Rustenburg towards Swartruggens, on Tuesday 11 October at around 7h30.

Two cars – a Nissan Skyline and an Isuzu – were travelling in the same direction towards Swartruggens when the left front wheel of the Nissan broke. The

car swerved towards the Isuzu and collided with it, causing the Isuzu to collide with another oncoming vehicle.

“The male driver of the Nissan, injured his neck while the woman driver of the Isuzu sustained back injuries. Both were taken to hospital,” said an eyewitness. The SAPS are currently investigating.
