Longest Breakfast Table

Rustenburg – A breakfast for kings, laughter all around, waiters scurrying around... in essence a day where 1172 hungry patrons sat down to feast at the Longest Breakfast Table at the Waterfall Mall in aid of charity.

Tuesday morning (October 18) kicked off with an attempt to break all standing records, and in a record time this goal was achieved by an astounding 60 people, beating last year's record of 1112 people attending. Last year's record of 330 meters, concerning the distance of the tables, was easily beaten, with a new distance of 372 metres.

In addition, serving breakfast to all these patrons saw a new record of 14 min 19s compared to the previous 14 min 49s, making it 30 seconds of triumph! Possible acknowledgment by the Guinness World Book of Records is also on the table.

Set in motion in 2007, the Longest Breakfast Table became one of the highlights on the Rustenburg Calendar, with each year grows from strength to strength.
