MEGA Water & Sanitation project in the pipeline for Rustenburg

Rustenburg – A R400-million to R500-million water and sanitation services expansion project is in the pipeline for Rustenburg. During a telephonic interview with Corrie Marx of Bigen Africa, a trustee of the Rustenburg Water Services Trust (RWST), he confirmed that Bigen Africa will be handing in the preliminary plan of action to the Rustenburg Local Municipality on Monday 31 October. The Rustenburg Water Services Trust is a joint venture between the Rustenburg Local Municipality, ABSA, Bigen Africa and Magalies Water. They were faced with various challenges including an aging water reticulation infrastructure. One of the main focus areas of the Trust is to re-commission the Bospoort Dam Water Purification Works to reduce the dependency of Rustenburg Local Municipality on external water supplies. Water from the works is then distributed to the Rustenburg area. Strategies to eradicate the backlogs in water and sanitation services are required to ensure the effective roll of the programme as the millennium targets were set by the National Government for access to water and sanitation in 2008 and 2010 respectively. Subsequently the targets were set for 2014 for all services. Although the municipality is required by law to have a plan in place, spanning over at least 5 years, the RWST was urged to commence with the next phase of expansion to meet the growing needs of the Rustenburg municipality, where growth continues to be driven by the mining sector. “Capital plans like these take time, it involves not only the authorisation by local government and eventually government itself, it also has to take into consideration an affordable project-finance plan for the municipality,” Marx added. A detailed project outline would be provided within three to four months by Bigen Africa Engineering and the Platinum Weekly would keep you updated.

Safety Tips: Kids & Swimming...

Splashing, wading, and paddling – it must mean a great day in the water! Playing at the beach, at a water park, by a lake, or in a pool can be a real treat on a hot day. Swimming is a lot of fun, but drowning is a real danger. Even kids who know how to swim can drown ... let's find out how to stay safe in the water.



Rules:

- Always have an adult watch you when you are in the pool – even in your own backyard. Never go in the pool if there is no adult around. Always call an adult or lifeguard if there is an emergency.
- Gates are around pools for a reason – to keep kids away from the water when there isn't a lifeguard or adult around to watch them. Never go through any pool gates when they are closed. Stay safe and stay out!
- Swim with a buddy.
- If you're learning to swim, ask your mom or dad to make sure your flotation devices are Coast Guard approved.
- Walk slowly in the pool area. Don't run.
- Swim at a depth that is safe for you. If you're just learning to swim, stay in the shallow end.
- Don't push or jump on others. You could accidentally hurt someone or yourself.
- Toys to help you float come in many shapes and sizes (an inner tube, air mattress, or beach ball, for example). Although they're fun and can help you while you learn to swim, what they can't do is save a life. They're toys that can lose air or float away.
- Don't chew gum or eat while you swim – you could choke.
