Stars should have been ahead on nine minutes as Elias Ngwepe set up Joseph

Malangoane; but the youngster sliced his effort wide with only Arthur Bartman in the Chiefs goal to beat. But they did take the lead on 37 minutes when the admirable Sibusiso Msomi led a counter-attack, breaking down the right wing. His precise cross found Botes, who side-footed home past a helpless Bartman.

Chiefs were level as Siphwe Tshabalala set up Ngcobo to score from six-yards, and although there was a hint of offside, the goal stood. The final 10 minutes was also Stars as they pressed for a winner, forcing both Jimmy Tau and Lehlohonolo Majoro to clear off the line, while Bartman also produced a string of fine saves. The match went into extra-time and it was former Chiefs man Phala who netted the winner. He was played into space on the right and his low drive was too good for Bartman.
