



**NOTICE OF AMENDMENT TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME REPORT AT WATERVAL SMELTER**

Notice is hereby given in terms of the Minerals and Petroleum Resources Development Act (No. 28 of 2002) (MPRDA), of the intent to carry out an Environmental Management Programme Report (EMPR) Amendment Process to incorporate the secondary mill expansion and existing slag stockpiles at Anglo American Platinum Limited: Waterval Smelter (Waterval Smelter).

**DESCRIPTION**

Anglo American Platinum Limited intends to upgrade the existing milling facilities at its Waterval Smelter, near Rustenburg, to recover additional Platinum Group Metals (PGMs). The upgrade will be known as the secondary mill expansion project and result in an increase in the tonnage of treatable slag and a decrease in the volume of slag transferred to the existing residue stockpiles. Waterval Smelter proposes to amend its existing EMPR to incorporate environmental management measures for the project in line with the MPRDA. The impacts relating to the management of the project will be assessed as part of an environmental impact assessment (EIA) process; which is required to amend the existing EMPR. The amendment process will also involve a comprehensive and transparent stakeholder engagement process, the compilation of an EMPR, as well as public review of the report.

# OR Tambo Soccer Challenge Launched



**Rustenburg** – Platinum Stars will face Mamelodi Sundowns in one of the semi-finals of the inaugural OR Tambo Soccer Challenge which will be held at the Royal Bafokeng Sports Palace on 13 November.
