'Women who Care'

Rustenburg – Mothers and mothers-to-be recently received a surprise-visit from the Executive Mayor of Rustenburg, Cllr. Mpho Khunou together with his wife Favourite Khunou, on Tuesday 8 November at the Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital.

The Mayor and his wife donated food parcels as a small token of assistance, as part of an initiative led by the 'Women Who Care' group, based in Zinniaville. These donations are set to become a weekly feature as the community – who are receiving massive support from families living in Zinniaville – have pledged to make donations every Tuesday in order to assist women at the hospital.

"These donations commenced on Mandela Day. So, with the assistance of the Rustenburg Local Municipality, they are now donating every Tuesday," said Mrotukile Setlhoai, communication manager at Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital.

A member of Women Who Care, who did not want her name to be mentioned, said the foodstuffs are sources through donations by women who live in Zinniaville. She said, "We have 12 houses in Zinniaville that have pledged to donate two loaves each. So we end up getting a minimum of 24 loaves each week. There is going to be an increase in the donations due to more and more people wanting to be involved in this initiative."
