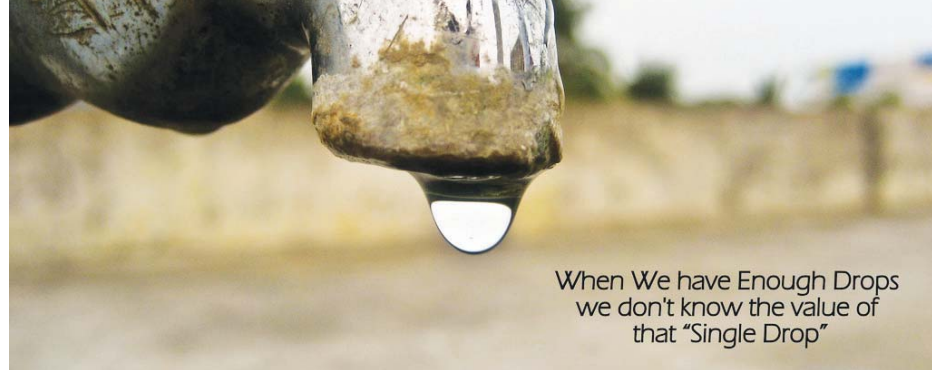
## Miner TRAPPED @ Harmony Gold

**Carletonville** – A spokesperson for Harmony Gold confirmed on Wednesday that a worker is trapped underground at its Kusasalethu mine (November 16). South Africa's third-largest gold producer said the miner, working night shift, was trapped after a seismic event triggered a fall of ground. "Rescue teams are currently trying

to reach the trapped person and the National Union of Mineworkers as well as the Department of Mineral Resources are on scene to assist," Harmony's spokeswoman Marian van der Walt said. She could not immediately confirm if production had been suspended while the rescue efforts were ongoing.

**Rustenburg** – According to reports, since 16th November 2011, one of the largest reservoirs near Rustenburg is totally empty/ drained even though there is a constant supply of water in and out of the reservoir. However, the Bospoort line has been opened to add additional water to our system at 5 Tanks. This water is more expensive than the RWB water but it is done to reduce risks and to secure our stocks of water as a remedial action.

- Municipality and residential areas;
- Mines including Anglo Platinum; and

**Certain control measures that must be taken include:**

- Stop all watering of gardens and lawns;
- Don't water down outside areas;
- Repair all water leaks on all drinking water systems – immediately; and
