

Stacking up for Charity NEW Guinness World Record

Rustenburg – The World Sport Stacking Association set a new Guinness World Record on Thursday, 17 November 2011, for “the most people stacking speed cups at multiple locations in one day”.

Selly Park Primary (Rustenburg) helped them achieve this goal! Literally, 26 countries from around the world participated during this day, with 2 264 stackers from South Africa. Up to 204 learners from Grades 1 to 3 stacked speed cups for ½ hour in the school hall and as an “entrance fee” to this exciting event, a tin of canned food was charged. These items were then donated to the G-Om/Wee Care Project and collected by Mrs Linda Grobler for distribution.
