

NFVF launches 'In Conversation With'...

Rustenburg – Following their successful involvement in the recently hosted Bojanala Film Week, the National Film and Video Foundation (NFVF) on Wednesday 30th of November launched the inaugural session of In Conversation With... 'In Conversation With' is a series of film industry stakeholder interaction-sessions. The main objective of the project is to bring film industry stakeholders together with the purpose of sharing insights and expertise on issues relating to the film industry.

Facilitated by Clarence Hamilton, NFVF's head of Production and Development, and attended by industry delegates including filmmakers and film commissions' representatives, the session's first guest was Junaid Ahmed from Finline Productions.

During the session, Junaid informed the guests that his motivation comes from telling stories through the eyes of ordinary people, and that with 'More Than Just a Game' he wanted "to change the face of Africa and how it is perceived globally."

"Pitching your film idea is a one-time opportunity to impress and to capture interest for your project. The key goal is to get the right message across to potential investors and plant a seed for subsequently closing a financial deal. "One thing I have realized is that there is funding out there, however local producers need to know how to tap-in to those opportunities," he added.

Roll-a-Quad raises funds



Rustenburg – Thousands of Rands were raised on Saturday 3 December 2011 after an abundant amount of businesspeople took part in the Roll-a-Quad competition in order to help raise funds for the North West Disability sports fund.

The event was held at the Olympia Park Stadium in Rustenburg from 14h30 and entry was pegged at R5 for children and R10 for adults. Participating teams also paid R500 to compete in the event. Karel Christie – who was one of the organisers of the event – said although a lot of money was raised by the event, they failed to

reach their target of R30 000. He said, "There was a good response from the teams that participated – because they came in their numbers. We had 12 teams in total that took part in the contest. However, we were disappointed with the low turnout of people from the community; we were expecting a larger number." Karel revealed that the event will be held annually as a contribution to sportspersons in the Province living with disabilities.
