Entrepreneurs would be provided the opportunity to gain business experience and to establish and develop their own business, creating new jobs in the process.

The EIP aims to be a catalyst for entrepreneurs interested in developing or growing a business, but who do not have access to the requisite skills, industry knowledge, business networks and support. Interns will be provided programmatic and experiential learning, which will equip them with the necessary skills to successfully establish and grow their business by the end of 2012.
