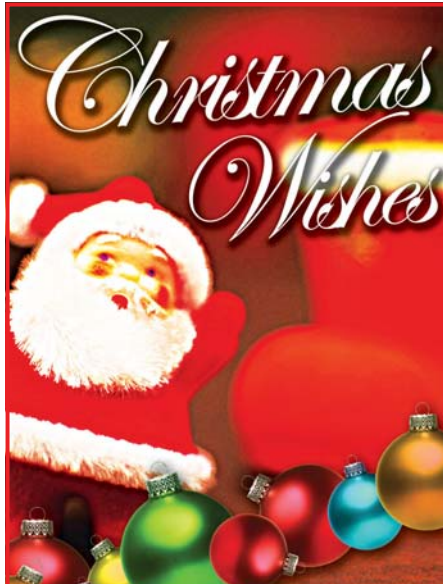

Tlokwe owed R3 million in unpaid electricity

Potchefstroom – The Tlokwe City Council last month resolved to cut electricity as part of strict measures to recover the more than R3 million that they are owed in outstanding service delivery accounts.

Likely to be hard hit in this regard are many local schools and businesses during the December 2011 to January 2012 period. The Council has noted that local schools owed the municipality no less than R3,06 million for longer than sixty days on outstanding service delivery accounts as on June 20, 2011.

Government departments that have local offices with outstanding service delivery accounts will also not be excluded from the pending action. Services are due to be cut as from December 13, 2011.

The municipality will forward letters to all government departments, schools and businesses to inform them of its intention to disconnect services in accordance with its credit control and debt collection policies. The North West Provincial Premier and the MEC for Education will also be informed of the decision.

In addition to the pending action, the manager of Finance has been instructed to investigate the possibility of installing, free of charge, pre-paid meters in all schools. The council will consider a report in this regard in its next meeting.
