

Skoonmaak ná dood- of misdadaadtoneel?

Rustenburg – Wat gemaak nadat 'n geliefde sterf en die misdadaad- en/of ongelukstoneel jou in die oë staar? Wat gemaak as jy dit nie oor jou hart kan kry om 'n toneel te betree waar 'n geliefde hul laaste oomblikke spandeer het nie?

Hierdie is nie 'n maklike gesprek nie.

Meeste mense verkies om nie self 'n misdadaad- en/of ongelukstoneel skoon te maak nie, geheel en al verstaanbaar – maar wie kan help in so 'n situasie?

Die *Platinum Weekly koerant* het vandeeweek 'n onderhoud gevoer met Ettiëne Aucamp en Janine Hansen. Die twee, aan die stuur van *CIA (Crime Incident Accident) Rustenburg*, bied 24 uur per dag, 7 dae 'n week, die tipe dienste aan.

“Ons bied 'n wye verskeidenheid dienste aan insluitende misdadaadtoneel opruimwerk, moord- en dood opruimwerk, bloed en dekomposisie opruimwerk en waar nodig ook herstelwerk en opknappingswerk,” aldus Ettiëne Aucamp, eienaar van *CIA Rustenburg*.

“Vir enige persoon wie iemand aan die dood afgestaan het, is die skoonmaak van die toneel 'n bleek vooruit-sig,” sê Janine Hansen, bestuurder van *CIA Rustenburg*. Hierdie span werk hand-aan-hand met die Polisie, noodpersoneel en betrokke instansies. Persoonlike gebeurtenisse word met oorleg, respek en flink diens hanteer. *CIA Rustenburg* is gebaseer in Rustenburg, maar hul operasie strek regoor die Noordwes asook Limpopo provinsie.

“Buiten die ooglopende dienste, strek die voordele om van ons dienste gebruik te maak heelwat verder. Tonele waar iemand oorlede is, is ook 'n gesondheidsrisiko vir die in die onmiddellike omgewing. As daar nie van

die korrekte voorsorgmaatreëls, skoonmaakmiddels, kleredrag en tegnieke gebruik gemaak word nie, is dit 'n gesondheidsrisiko,” sê Aucamp.

Aan diegene in noue kontak met die oorledenes, soos reddingswerkers en die span van *CIA Rustenburg*, bestaan die gesondheidsrisiko om blootgestel te word aan chroniese aansteeklike siektes deur middel van direkte en indirekte kontak, insluitend hepatitis B en hepatitis C, MIV, dermatogene, tuberkulose en cholera. *CIA Rustenburg* is OSHA (*Occupational Safety and Health Act*) gesertifiseerd deur middel van *Amdecon CTS* – wat internasionaal erken word.

Bende sak toe op Koster-plaas

Koster – Drie mans het toegesak op 'n plaas net buite Koster op Maandag, 6 Februarie 2017, en voorgegee om vee te wil koop.

Die boer, eienaar van die plaas, het die drie mans nie onbeholpe gelaat nie, maar kort voor lank het twee addisionele aanvallers te voorskyn gekom. Die haal toe 'n vuurwapen uit en rig die vuurwapen op die boer.

Volgens Sersant Kelebogile Moleko, polisiewoordvoerder, het die vyf mans die boer en sy vrou vasgebind met tou en hul aangehou in hul woning.

'n Skootrekenaar, juwele, twee vuurwapens en 'n Nissan bakkie is gebuit. Die Polisie is verwittig, en na vin-nige reaksie is drie van die vyf benedelede vasgetrek. Die voertuig, juwele en skootrekenaar is verhaal.

Twee benedelede is steeds op vrye voet en die polisieondersoek duur voort.

Die drie aangekeerde verdagtes, tussen 24 en 30 jaar, sal na bewering voor die Koster Landdroshof verskyn op Woensdag, 8 Februarie 2017 in verband met huisbraak.

Surrender your Estate Firearms

Rustenburg/ Phokeng – “The Phokeng Police here-with urges the community to surrender their estate firearms, if they do not have the appropriate authorization or executor's letter,” Sgt Gabaiphiwe Kgatlha, police

spokesperson, said.

An estate firearm is a firearm, which belongs to a person that has passed away, and now in the possession of his/her family or friends.

“When surrendering an estate firearm, you must also bring a certified copy of the identity document and death certificate of the deceased. The necessary forms will also be provided, to be filled out,” Kgatlha added.

Five nabbed for smallholding robberies, rape and murder

Rustenburg/ Kroondal – The wave of crime in Rustenburg, especially the gruesome and aggravating nature thereof, is cause for serious concern.

After the numerous reported incidents extending over the past three weeks, the Rustenburg Cluster Task Team assembled their strengths and successfully arrested five Zimbabwean nationals, Sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi, police spokesperson, said.

The five, aged between 23 and 37, were arrested in the Ikemeleng (Matebeleng) informal settlement near Kroondal in the early hours of Friday, 3 February 2017.

They were arrested for rape, murder and house robbery.

The arrest emanated after a spate of rape, murder and robberies were reported within a four-day period in the Kroondal and surrounding vicinity.

As reported in the previous edition of the *Platinum Weekly* newspaper, an elderly couple residing in Waterfall Village, Rustenburg, was fast asleep on Sunday evening, 29 January 2017 at approximately 22h20 when they woke up to the sound of dogs barking.

The husband went outside to investigate.

The elderly lady became more wary as her husband did not return, so she also went out. She came across her husband wrestling with two assailants. “He was fighting for his life,” Captain Augoustides, police spokesperson, said. The woman screamed for help and ran inside the house. The attackers soon followed but had to break through the dining room window to gain entry.

They dragged the elderly man inside the house... The elderly woman soon realised her husband had been killed.

She was pistol-whipped [the assailants used a handgun as a blunt weapon] after which they started to rape the elderly lady.

They then demanded jewellery and cash. They also forced her to open the safe.

The elderly couple were robbed of TV sets, DVD players, clothes, a wrist watch, jewellery, cell phones and a firearm.

The suspects fled the scene on foot.

When the five assailants were arrested, two pistols with live rounds of ammunition, one belonging to the elderly couple, and jewellery items were recovered. The other items have apparently been sold.

The five suspects were expected to appear in the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Monday, 6 February 2017, facing charges of murder, rape, house robbery, possession of suspected stolen goods and the illegal possession of a firearm and ammunition.

At this stage, preliminary investigations indicate that the five suspects are very likely linked to other reported crimes in the area.

Shoprite Money Market SCAM

Rustenburg/ Phokeng – The Phokeng Police issued a stern warning to the community, to refrain from bogus or fake calls, claiming to be Shoprite employees.

The Police are currently investigating several fraud cases, where Rustenburg community members deposit cash into their friends or family members' accounts via Shoprite Money Market... and then it vanishes.

The modus operandi of the suspects is to call the victims from a variety of cell phone numbers, claiming that a 'system fault' has been logged at the Shoprite Money Market.

“The perpetrators tell the victims that their pins and reference numbers are incorrect, and to make the transaction go through, they must supply the incorrect pins and reference numbers in order to get 'new' codes. After the exchange of new references and pins, the money is then withdrawn by the perpetrator,” Sgt Gabaiphiwe Kgatlha, police spokesperson, said.

This scam has been running since October 2016.
