The communities utilised the opportunity to voice out their concerns regarding the high rate of crime, drug abuse, including dissatisfaction over the manner in which police are handling reported cases. The community requested that Dr Mokgantshang Mpho Motlhabane, and the Provincial Police Commissioner, Lt Gen Baile Motswenyane, who both attended this event, to intervene in the involvement of certain police officers in acts of criminality.

build a crime-free society, a safe and secured nation.”
