3-CAR-PILE-UP ON R24

Rustenburg – Three vehicles, a bus loaded with school children, and two road maintenance vehicles were involved in a three vehicle pile-up on Monday, 27 February 2017 on the R24. According to Trauma Rescue station manager, Weyland Bothma, emergency personnel were notified of the accident at 10:35 on Monday morning. They were dispatched to the scene where they found children wandering next to the road. Ten patients had to be stabilised on scene before being transported to hospital by several emergency response companies. One patient was treated for a fracture and fortunately no one was seriously injured.



Three vehicles, including a bus full of children, were involved in an accident on the R24.

EIENDOMSBELASTING EN DIE LANDBOUER

Wet 6 van 2004 onder die titel "Municipal Property Rates Act" het in 2008 in werking gekom. In ooreenstemming met die Grondwet se artikel 229, word 'n verpligting geplaas op alle grondeienaars van landbougrond om belasting te betaal. Soos dorpsbewoners aan die plaaslike munisipaliteit grond of eiendomsbelasting moet betaal, moet eienaars van landbougrond ook eiendomsbelasting, volgens die waardasie van die eiendom deur die plaaslike owerheid, betaal. Dit het niks met basiese dienste wat plaaslike owerhede lewer te doen nie, dit is nie 'n heffing of 'n rekening vir dienste gelewer nie, dit is 'n belasting. Belastingenskuld verjaar nie soos enige ander skuld na drie jaar nie, maar wel eers na dertig jaar. Wanneer 'n eienaar van landbougrond daardie grond, op water wyse ook al wil vervreem, hetsy dit te wil verkoop of te laat vererf, moet die agterstallige belasting eers aan die plaaslike owerheid betaal word, met rente op agterstallige skuld, voor 'n uitklaringsertifikaat uitgereik sal word ten einde die transaksie af te sluit. Oordrag kan nie plaasvind sonder hierdie uitklaringsertifikaat nie.

Baie min landbou grondeienaars is bewus daarvan dat hulle hierdie belasting aan die plaaslike owerheid verskuldig is, omdat hulle nie rekening van die plaaslike owerheid ontvang nie. Ten spyte van die feit dat 'n verpligting op die munisipaliteit geplaas word om rekening uit te stuur, bepaal die wet egter ook dat die grondeienaar wat nie 'n rekening ontvang nie, sy verpligting van betaling moet besef en navraag moet doen oor die aangeleentheid by sy plaaslike munisipaliteit. Die onus berus dus op die grondeienaar om sy rekening by die owerheid te bekom en dit betyds te betaal. Die plaaslike owerhede is dan ook by magte om die agterstallige belasting in te vorder op enige wetlike manier. Hulle kan dagvaardings teen jou uitreik en die normale skuld-invorderings prosesse gebruik. TLU SA het namens hulle lede met verskeie plaaslike owerhede onderhandel om agterstallige skuld af te skryf en om kortings op die belasting te probeer beding binne die wetlike raamwerk wat daargestel is. Onderhandelinge is suksesvol afgehandel met verskeie owerhede en is hierdie voordeel wat beding

was nie net vir TLU SA lede beding nie maar vir alle grondeienaars, self die eienaars van sommige dorp eiendomme soos Mogwadi (Dendron) in die Limpopo Provinsie en in die munisipale gebied van die nuut saam-gestelde munisipaliteit met die samevoeging van Modimolle, (Nyl-stroom) en Mookgophong (Naboomspruit). SHOOTOUT WITH TRANSIT SECURITY

Mooiwooi – A 36-year old suspect appeared before the Brits Magistrates' Court on Thursday, 2 March 2017, facing charges of the illegal possession of a firearm, ammunition, attempted armed robbery and attempted murder. "He was arrested on Tuesday, 28 February 2017, at a shopping complex in Mooiwooi," lieutenant colonel Pelonomi Makau, police spokesperson, said. The arrested, and three of his accomplices, allegedly robbed a

cash-in-transit security vehicle. At the time of the robbery, the transit vehicle was doing a cash pickup at the shopping complex. The arrested suspect allegedly fired a shot at the security officials, and hit one of the officials in the hand. The remaining three suspects fled in their getaway vehicle, but the police managed to arrest one on scene. They were quick on scene. The suspects did not manage to get their hands on cash.

RAPE SUSPECT IN COURT

Rustenburg – A 29-year old suspect appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Tuesday, 28 February 2017, on charges of rape. "A 32-year old woman was raped in Phot-
