There was not much separating the two sides in the opening 10 minutes as they were both still trying to find their rhythm in the match.

Dikwena finally found the breakthrough four minutes before halftime, through Gift Sithole who made all their dominance count for one goal lead before half time.

Platinum Stars played without head coach Roger De Sa, who was suspended last Friday, and the visitors Free State Stars levelled goals in the nine minutes remaining of the match with a fine strike from Anas.
