Derby/ Ventersdorp – Eight people died and five of them burned beyond recognition when a bakkie collided with a minibus between Derby and Ventersdorp on Tuesday night, 10 April.

According to the law enforcement authorities at the scene, both vehicles burst into flames on impact. Seven people were certified dead on the scene. Two were rushed to the nearest hospital where one person succumbed to injuries. The bakkie was traveling from Ventersdorp's direction to Derby with two occupants, while

the minibus, carrying seven people including the driver was travelling from Derby towards Ventersdorp.

North West MEC for community safety and transport management, Dr Mpho Motlhabane has sent his heartfelt condolences to the families and wished a speedy recovery to the surviving passenger. The cause of the accident is not yet known, however, a case of culpable homicide is being investigated by the police.

16 escaped from Jhb prison

The prisoners escaped by breaking through iron bars before breaking a wall and jumping the prison fence on their way out.

Police await post-mortem results

Mooinooi – The headless body of a person found lying in a street in Mooinooi on 29 March has been sent for post-mortem analysis.

A spokesperson for the police, sergeant Kelebogile Moleko told Platinum Weekly that police couldn't find anything on the body to help establish the deceased's identity. "We can only estimate that he was in his thirties," she said.

Members of the community are also requested to assist the police in Mooinooi in identifying the body. The deceased's body was found wearing a brown t-shirt, blue jersey, black pair of jeans and a brown waist belt.

The police request anyone with information that may lead to identification of the body or locating the family of the deceased to call detective sergeant Sello on 079-357 4633.
