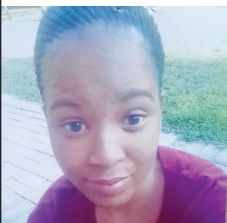


HELP POLICE FIND TWO MISSING TEENAGERS

Mahikeng – Two teenage girls from Mahikeng have gone missing and police are urging the community to assist them locate their whereabouts. Nobuhle Sizane (18) and Thembiswa Saul (17) were reported missing on 5 and 8 May respectively. According to lieutenant colonel Pelonomi Makau, police spokesperson, Sizane was last seen on Friday, 5 May in Lonely Park, Mahikeng. “She was wearing a maroon t-shirt and a maroon pair of jeans. She was walking home from Mahikeng Mall.” Thembiswa was last seen on Tuesday, 8 May. “She is from Imperial Reserve, Mahikeng, and was last seen going to the Montshiwastad Clinic. She was wearing a red top tanktop and a black t-shirt. Mahikeng – Police in Lomanyaneng near Mahikeng request members of the community to assist in tracing two missing persons; Banyatsi Joseph Moreole (44) of house No. 10862 Lotlhakane village, and Khumo Moremi (17) of Mosiane View, Majemantsho. According to brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone, police spokesperson, Moreole who is reported to be a psychiatric patient, went missing on Friday, 15 December 2017 after leaving the village to attend a night vigil and funeral in Lomanyaneng. “He has a round scar on the forehead.” Khumo was a learner at Danville Secondary School outside Mahikeng.
