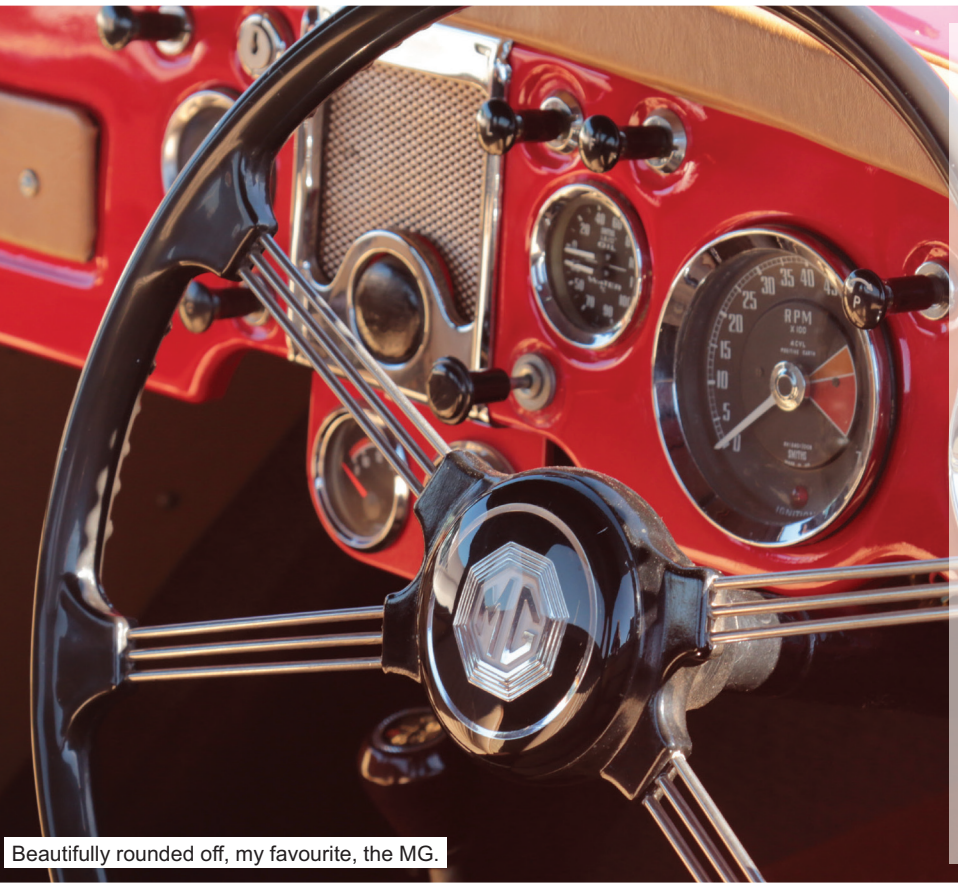


GOLDEN OLDIES ROAR
