Rustenburg – A fun run to raise funds for Jaco Fourie (20), who suffered devastating injuries in a car accident in March this year, will be held on 15 September at the Impala Rugby Club. The young God-fearing student-teacher, with a zest for life, needs to undergo a hip replacement, rehabilitation and physiotherapy as well as psychological therapy, following the accident. The cost for a deposit to enable him access to treatment for just one month is R165 600.00. The heavy toll of his expenses has already exhausted his

father’s medical aid. Good Samaritans are invited to take part in this noble event, which, besides the fun run has food stalls and jumping castles to entertain young and old. Jaco’s friend, Elisma, who was also involved in the accident, said: “Jaco’s situation is not getting any better. He lacks rehabilitation and equipment support.” The fun run would consist of a two and four km route, and the registration fee is R20 and R40 respectively. MOTHER ALLEGEDLY STABBED HER 4-YEAR SON TO DEATH

Rustenburg – The 36-year old Doreen Ramonye of Phokeng has been charged with the murder of her own son. She appeared before the Tlhabane Magistrates’ Court on Wednesday 29 August. Police spokesperson, sergeant Kelebogile Moleko, told *Platinum Weekly* that the case has been postponed to 17 September. She said the deceased’s body was found with stabbed wounds some 100 metres away from where he stayed with the accused. The police could not confirm if the accused would be referred for psychiatric observation. The accused, Doreen Ramonye, will be kept in custody until her next court appearance.

Soos dinge op die oomblik lyk, berei haar familie hulself voor om vir die volgende ses maande Adel by te staan met rehabilitasie. Die dokters kan nog nie die aard van haar breinskade opgedoen, bepaal nie. Slegs ‘n beraamde pad na herstel kan gedoen word. Adel, die meisie wat ons ken, is ‘n dapper vegter. Adel is ‘n tweedejaар bedryfsielkunde student aan die Universiteit van Pretoria en het op Rustenburg skoolgegaan. Sy was op skool ‘n uitbinker netbalspeler en is ‘n doelgerigte meisiekind, wat geblom het waar sy geplant was. Tans voer sy elke dag ‘n stryd teen die terugslag wat haar getref het. Sy stry nie alleen nie. Haar ouers, Joanita en Frank, broer James, en die hele uitgebreide familie en vriende groep bid vir haar herstel en ondersteun haar. Emosioneel, fisies en geestelik verg dit baie van almal betrokke. Ons vra jul ondersteuning aan die familie in hierdie beproewende tyd. Hou hulle in jul gebede. Bied asseblief hulp as jul kans sien. As jul ‘n finansiële bydrae kan maak, om kostes wat die mediese fonds nie dek nie, te help delg, sal dit baie druk van die familie verlig.
