

R52 UPGRADES

Road improvement creates opportunities for locals

Koster/ Rustenburg – Road users in the Bojanala Platinum District Municipality will be brought closer to various destinations as SANRAL embarks on a project to improve the R52 which is the shortest and most convenient route between Koster and Rustenburg.

The road is currently a 38.7km, two-lane single-carriageway from Koster to Rustenburg, with gravel shoulders. Improvements will include the addition of paved shoulders as well as the construction of appropriate surfacing which will improve the overtaking opportunities and decrease the high risk of car crashes due to potholes. Motorists will enjoy these benefits at no extra cost as it will not be tolled. It will also make the stretch of road safer.

The R52 is at a very early stage of design which will take 24 months to complete, says SANRAL project manager, Lugisani Muravha. This will be followed by the construction commencing in mid-2020 to be completed 30 months later. A contractor will be appointed once the design has been completed.

Road users and communities of Bojanala Platinum District Municipality will benefit from the project through improved road safety and contracting opportunities for local SMMEs, says Muravha. Construction labour and sub-contractors will be sourced from the local municipality and district municipality respectively.

As at the end of June 2018, the roads agency has invested over R2.8 billion on various road maintenance, repair and upgrades in the North West province from January 2015. This investment is expected to increase to as much as R12.8 billion, as the 55 projects are moving closer to completion.

“SANRAL will continue to deliver quality infrastructure to enhance mobility in the region, says SANRAL’s regional manager for the northern provinces, Progress Hlahla. “We look forward to successfully implementing this project in line with our horizon 2030 strategy and our transformation policy which seeks to enhance transformation in the construction environment,” he added.
