Rustenburg – The African continent is going big with this year’s Birding Big Day (BBD) taking place Saturday 24 November. BirdLife South Africa will host their 34rd BBD. Ernst Retief, event organiser said: “During Birding Big Day 2016, more than a thousand birders recorded 654 species... a record! We also raised some essential funds for bird conservation. Throughout the 2018 event, we hope to break this record and have even more birders out enjoying nature.”

South Africa’s neighbours are also taking part in this challenge to see which country can log the most species in 24 hours. Namibia, Zimbabwe, Zambia, Kenya, Egypt and others, will host their own BBD’s.

Members of BirdLife Rustenburg, who have participated in this popular national annual bird count event, will share their experiences during the monthly meeting. The meeting will take place at 19:00 on Monday, 19 November, at the Methodist Church

on the corner of Brink and Schuurman Streets. All members and non-members are welcome; non-members must pay R20.00 per person. Tea, coffee and snacks will be served after the meeting. At the meeting, Wynand Sauerman and Hanti Mathews will share some of the highlights and photos of the Botswana event in October. Special birds that were seen include the Boulder Chat, Broad-billed Roller, African Pygmy Kingfisher, Diederick Cuckoo and many more.

On Saturday, 24 November, BirdLife Rustenburg will enter as many teams as possible to take part in the Birding Big Day and will try to see and hear as many bird species as possible, for 24 hours, in a 50km radius around Rustenburg.
